- **OSHA 1910.146(C) Required Confined Space Evaluations:** We will identify hazards and work procedures required for safe entry.
- **OSHA 1910.146(G) Required Training:** We provide your workers with the required knowledge to make safe entry and understand their roles.
- **OSHA 1910.146(H) Required Confined Space Attendants:** Serve as continual safety watch to monitor the conditions inside and outside the space to ensure that work is progressing within the safe work guidelines established by the confined space permit.
- **OSHA 1910.146(K) Required On-Site Confined Space Rescue:** A Rescue team acts as a standby in the event that an emergency arises.

What is a confined space?

Confined spaces are any area that is large enough to bodily enter to perform work, not designed for continual employee occupancy and has limited or restricted means of access or egress. OSHA 1910.146(B)

Other hazards to consider:

Some spaces also include additional hazards such as atmospheric hazards, entrapment hazards or serious safety and health hazards.

Industrial Hygiene Sampling

What is Industrial Hygiene?

Industrial hygiene, by definition, is the science devoted to the anticipation, recognition, evaluation and control of those environmental factors to protect worker's health and safety. The primary goal of industrial hygienist is to protect the health and well-being of workers by identifying and minimizing exposure to hazardous substances and physical agents in the workplace. OSHA has developed and mandated many health requirements in more than six million U.S. workplaces. These requirements include air contaminants as well as chemical, biological, physical, and ergonomic hazards.

Our hygienists take a sample of the air/material and write a report explaining the results of the sampling and recommendations for abatement. This report is then provided to the company.

SRCO can conduct Physical Facility Audits in compliance with the American Correctional Association including Indoor Air Quality, CO₂, CO, Temperature, Humidity, Noise, and Ventilation Testing. A written report based on the results of this testing is included with the audit.

Air Monitor Repair and Service

What are Air Monitors?

This equipment is used when trying to determine how safe an environment is for breathing, such as in a Confined Space. Typically used to detect Oxygen, Hydrogen Sulfide, Carbon Monoxide, and Combustible Gases (LEL), a 4-gas multi gas detector is the most common Air Monitor in use. A 5-gas monitor detects the same 4 gases as a 4-gas monitor but it will also detect an additional gas such as Volatile Organic Compounds. This 5th sensor can be calibrated to other gases. These monitors allow for a confined space attendant to monitor the air inside a space without entering the space his/herself.

A single gas detector is calibrated to a single gas typically Oxygen (O₂), Hydrogen Sulfide (H₂S) or Carbon Monoxide (CO) but there are others as well. These monitors are designed for a single person to wear on his/her body inside the breathing space while that person is working in an area that has the potential for a hazardous environment.

How can SRCO Help?

Calibrations: This is the process of verifying or adjusting a gas monitor's accuracy against a known, traceable standard of gas. It is recommended to calibrate air monitors frequently.

Bump Tests: The monitor is exposed briefly to a known concentration of gas to ensure that the sensors and alarms are working correctly. Bump Tests should be completed before each use of the monitor.

Repairs: Sensors, screens, and clips eventually all need replaced. SRCO keeps a wide range of parts in stock to repair monitors as needed.

Services are available for a wide variety of monitors including BW, Gas Clip, MSA and RKI.

Breathing Air and Fit Testing Services

Breathing Air Services

Self Contained Breathing Apparatus: SCBAs are used in confined spaces and areas that are considered IDLH or immediately dangerous to life and health. This is where the quality of air is considered not to breathing levels.

Services SRCO can Provide

- **Hydrostatic Testing:** This is the process of subjecting the breathing air cylinder to a pressure higher than during normal usage. Hydrostatic testing is done to verify that the structural integrity of the cylinder is sound and can properly contain safe breathing air. During testing the cylinder is monitored for dents, leaks, and other signs of weakness. A visual inspection is also completed during this time for any damage, corrosion or defects. Testing should be completed at a minimum of every 5 years.
- **Cylinder Refills:** SRCO is certified to refill SCBA bottles with breathing quality air.
- **Rental Equipment:** SRCO provides rental fresh air equipment, including bottles, lines and respirators.

Respirator Fit Testing and Medical Evaluations

Respirator Fit Testing: SRCO offers both Qualitative and Quantitative fit testing. Whether your using a N95 dust mask or a SCBA we are able to provide the testing you need. We can provide testing on many different brands including Scott, 3M, North, and MSA.


Medical Evaluations: SRCO provides Medical Evaluations through an online platform and can complete these onsite or prior to the scheduled fit testing time. Employees receive a copy of the approved evaluation and fit test after completion.

Fire Extinguisher Services

At Safety Resources Company of Ohio, our certified technicians can help with any of your fire extinguisher needs.

- **Monthly and Annual Inspections:** OSHA 1910.157(E) Fire Extinguishers need monthly and annual inspections to ensure they are functional and ready for use in an emergency. Anything can happen and we want you to be prepared. Inspections are available either on site or at our office.
- **6 Year Inspections:** This is known as a breakdown inspection or service. The extinguisher is taken apart, inspected and refilled by our licensed professionals.
- **Recharging:** Once a fire extinguisher has been discharged or in the event of pressure loss, your extinguisher needs to be recharged. Trust our licensed professionals to get your extinguishers checked and filled promptly.
- **Hydrotesting:** OSHA 1910.157(F) Hydrotesting is necessary to ensure the fire extinguisher is working properly and has no faults that are not visible to the naked eye. This includes issues with the threads, seals, or shell.

Hazard Communication Services

A Hazard Communication Program is designed to ensure that employees are informed about the hazardous chemicals they may encounter in the workplace. This helps the employees ensure their own safety when working around chemicals and prevent accidents or injuries while on the job.

Chemical Inventory and Safety Data Sheets: SRCO can help develop a comprehensive chemical inventory and provide a book of all current SDS sheets for the chemicals found in your inventory. Regular reviews of the chemical inventory and SDS book can also be done.

Safety Labels and Signage: Signs that can be found throughout the facility must also meet certain requirements both in size and appearance. Safety Resources can create and maintain both hazard communication labels and signs throughout the facility.

Lockout/Tagout

Lockout/Tagout is the control of hazardous energy. It is meant to prevent the startup of machinery or the release of stored energy during maintenance or servicing of equipment that can potentially cause injury to employees.

LOTO is one part of an overall Hazardous Energy Control Program and requires written procedures for each piece of equipment. Locks and tags must be able to survive the environment they are being used in. Employee's must be trained on understanding the written procedures, the hazards associated with the machines and comprehension of lockout devices and tags.

Safety Resources provides LOTO policies, written procedures and the training for affected/authorized employees. LOTO tags and devices are also available.
